Who We Are/What We Do

The South Central Regional Library Council is a non-profit organization chartered in 1967 by the Regents of the University of the State of New York for the purpose of identifying, strengthening and sharing library resources in the fourteen counties of South Central New York State. The Regional Library Council receives its basic operating funds from the State of New York.

SCRLC members include 20 academic libraries, 3 public library systems, 3 public libraries, 6 school library systems, 19 hospital libraries, 14 special libraries, 7 supreme court libraries, and 2 affiliates. SCRLC provides the following services to its members:

- Coordinated resources sharing
- Education and training
- Consortial database purchases
- Consulting
- Regional information technology projects
- Subsidies for InterLibrary Loan
- Access to grants
- Providing professional contacts and peer support
- Communications and publications
- Tools of History digitization project

HLSP

Hospital Library Services Program

HLSP was established in 1982 as an amendment to the New York State's Commissioner of Education Regulations Section 90.17. Funded by New York State, the HLSP program is a statewide effort to improve library services to the professional staff of not-for-profit hospitals in New York State. Nine Reference and Research Library Resources Systems statewide administer the HLSP program.
